





CHECKLIST FOR MTOs

PREPAREDNESS PHASE

1

Ensure drivers **adhere** to any **specific biosecurity requirements** of the farm and processing facility.



2

Drivers must declare ownership of cloven-hoofed animals (such as cattle, pigs, sheep, goats, alpacas) to their employer for traceability purposes.

Drivers must commence their shift showered, and in clean and sanitised footwear and clean, laundered clothing.

A clean, laundered change of clothes needs to be carried to change into and footwear must be cleaned and disinfected in the event of contamination with mud, animal manure or any other animal fluid whilst on farm.*

All steps must be taken to minimise contamination of external surfaces of tankers with mud, manure, and milk. Farms on which tankers or drivers become contaminated from milk collection areas, tanker tracks or road crossings must be reported to and followed up by field services.





Any driver that has entered Australia from a country not deemed free of FMD (including Indonesia and Bali) must not go on farm for at least 7 days. Alternate duties at site should be sought.





There must not be any non-essential contact with animals on farm or entry of drivers into any animal handling areas (such as the milking area).

*Additional PPE may be used to meet requirements with consideration and in line with best practice OH&S company policies and industry standards.
